Presentation Topic: Recruiting Employees who Will Thrive and Stay

Companies in Canada are having difficulty finding employees with the right set of skills for the job. Low labor force participation means fewer people available for employers to recruit. With



the aging population, it is becoming more difficult for employers to hire highly skilled workers. On top of the recruitment issues, companies have difficulty keeping employees engaged and motivated, leading to a high turnover rate. This session will discuss the benefits of a new Government backed CKCA program, outline the content of a seven-week course, discuss who is eligible and the qualifications they need, and review the logistics and procedures for hiring.

The government funded program will provide an intensive training course for newcomers to Canada in the kitchen cabinet making trade with a view of the different jobs found in a modern cabinet shop, from handcrafting and assembly to product repair and maintenance as well as instructions on product operations and safety, plus educational seminars on industry.
