- Registrants must book their own flights to and from the event, with arrival in Zurich, Switzerland no later than 11:30 am on Saturday, April 19 (allows for shuttle to Austria)
 - **Please ensure your passport is current and will not expire while away from Canada.** Always keep a photocopy of your passport at home, or with someone you can contact should you lose your passport while travelling. It is much easier to get a replacement passport, if you have access to a copy of it.
 - Registrants must book their own registration for entrance in to Eurocucina. We will share the link to register shortly.
 - Please provide CKCA with your travel itinerary for Zurich arrival (to confirm shuttle for BLUM).
